

Francis Zwiers

Prof. Zwiers is the Director of the Pacific Climate Impacts Consortium at the University of Victoria, which provides regional climate services to users in British Columbia and surrounding areas. His previous positions include Research Scientist (1984-2006), Chief of the Canadian Centre for Climate Modelling and Analysis (1997-2006) and Director of the Climate Research Division (2006-2010), all at Environment Canada. Prof. Zwiers' expertise is in the application of statistical methods to the analysis of observed and simulated climate variability and change. Prof. Zwiers is a Fellow of the Royal Society of Canada and of the American Meteorological Society, a recipient of the Meteorological Service of Canada Patterson Medal and the Statistical Society of Canada Impact Award, has served as a Coordinating Lead Author of the Fourth Assessment Report of the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC), and is an elected member of the IPCC Bureau.
